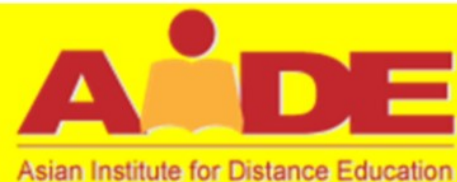

The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration program of the Asian Institute of Distance Education is one of the courses initially offered by the institute. In February 1985, the Bureau of Higher Education, which was then under the Department of Education Culture and Sports (DECS), authorized the institute to offer BSBA major in Management.

The other programs allowed by DECS to be offered by AIDE then were Associate in Arts and Bachelor of Arts program with majors in English, Economics, History, Sociology and Political Science.

As the Philippine higher education transitions to a different landscape, specially now that the K-12 program has been fully subsumed to the basic education curriculum, with its first batch to graduate in school year 2018-2019, all courses in college are also undergoing changes and revision. Apart from the implementation of K-12, the need to conform with an outcomes-based quality assurance system is also among the reasons for such change.
