
The goals of the business analytics specialization is to provide students the skills needed for different forms of Analytics namely, Descriptive, Predictive and Prescriptive Analytics. Also, the track will enable students to identify possible opportunities and implement or execute solutions for which these analytics can be used to solve business problems to aid intelligence and informed business decision-making.

The policies, standards and guidelines for the BSBA curriculum with specialization track on Business Analytics is covered by CHED Memo 39 series of 2006 and further amended in CHED Memo 11 series of 2013.

Realizing the importance of business analytics to drive decision making for optimal results, (See page 3) because I was about to enter college that time and was getting ready to take the entrance examinations. the AIDE had series of meetings with the SAS executives and officials to explore the possibility of incorporating the business analytics courses in its existing BSBA curriculum.

Should the agreement and partnership with SAS pushes through, the following courses can possibly be offered as a minor course in AIDE's BSBA major programs:

- 1. Fundamentals of Business Analytics,
- 2. Fundamentals of Data Warehousing,
- 3. Fundamentals of Descriptive Analytics,
- 4. Fundamentals of Predictive Analytics, and
- 5. Fundamentals of Prescriptive Analytics.

Currently, talks are still underway and the mechanics on the course offering are still being explored, although the content or the modules were already developed by SAS.
