The International Islamic University (IIU) of Islamabad, Pakistan hosted one of the biggest International Conference on Distance Education and E-Learning (ICDEEL 2016) in Asia held on December 9-20, 2016. It was spearheaded by the Directorate of Distance Education of IIU and Pakistan's Ministry of Higher Education which objective is to bring scholars and experts on distance education and e-learning.

In a country report delivered by Dr. CJ Sabio, former Vice President for Academic Affairs of the Pamantasang ng Lungsod ng Maynila (PLM), one of the invited Guest Speakers from Asia, she mentioned that the Asian Institute for Distance Education (AIDE) is one of the prominent and longest stand-alone distance education institutions in the Philippines along with CAP College foundation. Other institutions are of blended learning type as they combine distance education mode with their traditional face-face delivery, just like the Polytechnic University of the Philippines Open University System among others, she added.

Also, in her paper entitled "The Growth and Potential of Distance Education in Asia: A Country Report from the Philippines," Dr. Sabio stated the years of operation of AIDE which now spans to more than 30 years. She likewise mentioned the government program recognition granted by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) of the Philippines to all its programs unlike other distance education institutions operating in the country.
