True to its commitment to provide an alternative means of providing higher education in the country and to widen access to education by the young/millennials, working, non-working or adult learners, the AIDE has since started its operation at the heart of the country's business district—Makati.

During its initial years of operation its office is located along Ayala Avenue, Makati, specifically at the Bank of Commerce Building right in front of Philippine Stocks Exchange.

Currently, its office is located at the third floor of Greenbelt Mansion, which can be found along Perea Street, Makati City. As commonly known to everyone Makati City is located at the center of the National Capital Region (NCR) and is bounded by Pasig River on the north, the municipality of Pateros on the east, the City of Taguig on the southeast, the City of Pasay on the south and southwest and the City of Manila on the northwest.

The total land area of Makati accounts for 4.3% of Metro Manila's total land area. The City is composed of 33 barangays, which are distributed between two (2) legislative districts. It has the largest concentration of commercial activities in the Philippines, and is the country's primary link to international finance and the global economy. To be able to bring higher education right to the doorsteps of working adults and to respond to the problems of traffic congestion in the Metro, the office is strategically located along Greenbelt Compound so as to provide wider reach to working adults, millennials and even regular/newly graduate students in and outside Makati City especially that the delivery is through modular approach or via distance education mode.

The presence of several metropolitan-scale transport infrastructures (PNR line, MRT, SLEX, ED-SA, Circumferential Road 5) makes AIDE Office in Makati as one of the most accessible higher education institution in the City. Further, the high capacity transit systems and new infrastructure projects are expected to further increase the City's access to other transport infrastructure.
