AIDE to offer BSBA Operations Management Course in 2023



In the most recent years, we have received various requests to provide additional options on courses from our current and potential students. To start the year 2023 with a positive news, we are informing all our stakeholders that beginning January 2023, AIDE will start admitting students for the course BSBA Operations Management program.

As early as 2018, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) has provided the necessary government program recognition/permit that allowed AIDE to offer said program along with the other major courses under BSBA., e.g. Marketing Management (MM), Business Economics (BE) and Human Resource Management (HRM).
